Broaden your horizons on the East Lancs Explorer, and journey all the way up and down our 12 mile railway line! You and your friends can enjoy an **all-day train journey**, even **seeing areas of the railway that are not ordinarily open to the viewing public.**



On the tour enjoy:

- An uninterrupted diesel train journey along our whole line, starting from Bury Bolton Street station to Rawtenstall where you can relax whilst the locos run around the loop for the trip back. The train will be top and tailed by D335 and another from the ELR heritage diesel fleet.
- Return journey to Bury to be taken on a rare tour of Buckley Wells Locomotive Works. See some of the East Lancashire Railways resident loco's in a way you will never have seen them before as you learn about the effort that goes into maintaining and restoring these machines. **This area is usually closed to visitors!**
- Re-join the train and be taken to the ELR boundary at Green Lane, Heywood and return to Bury.

This tour starts at 11.00am at Bury Bolton Street and finishes back at Bury for approximately 4.40pm. It includes your full line return ticket, which itself includes **free entry to the Bury Transport Museum**, and an **exclusive tour of Buckley Wells** for **£19 per person**, a great value deal for a **full day out on the East Lancashire Railway!**
